Provision of induction loops in classrooms and hall	Equip at least 2 classrooms and hall with loop. (£1000?)	1 Key Stage 1 and 1 Key Stage 2 classroom, plus the hall adapted	2025	Loops installed. (costing?)
Provide ramp in Key Stage 1 up to Reception classroom	Install either permanent or provide a temporary ramp for access (£500?)	Check with LA for adaption	2025	Ramp available
Provide Disabled parking space	Set aside parking bay for disabled access. Labelled	Space available	2020	Space available
